Proposition No. 1

Facilities Capital Projects Levy

The Board of Directors of Central Kitsap School District No. 401 adopted Resolution #02-10-11 concerning a proposition for a capital projects levy. This proposition authorizes the District to undertake critical repairs to schools and facilities within the District, replace and upgrade computer technologies, replace Jackson Park Elementary School, modernize Silverdale Elementary School, relocate and consolidate Transportation Services; and authorizes the following excess levies for such purposes on all taxable property within the District:
