

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Kitsap County Board of Commissioners will hold a public hearing on **Monday, February 26, 2007, at the hour of 10:15 a.m.** in its Chambers at the County Administration Building, 619 Division Street, Port Orchard, Washington 98366, to consider a proposed **Ordinance** amending Chapter 2.32, Chapter 2.108, Chapter 11.04, Chapter 11.16 and Chapter 46.44 Kitsap County Code and Resolution 603-1979 relating to the **Kitsap County Department of Public Works**. A summary of the Ordinance Amendment follows:

Section 1 amends Kitsap County Code Section 2.32.010, "Department Established-Organization and Duties", to identify organizational chart and departmental duties and responsibilities.

Section 2 amends Kitsap County Code Section 2.32.020, "Director – Appointment and Duties", to define appointment of director and duties.

Section 3 amends Kitsap County Code Section 2.32.030, "Road Engineer designated", to identify designation of county road engineer.

Section 4 repeals Kitsap County Code Section 2.32.040.

Section 5 repeals Kitsap County Code Section 2.32.050.

Section 6 repeals Kitsap County Code Section 2.32.090.

Section 7 adds a NEW SECTION 2.32.110 to Chapter 2.32 establishing the county's policy for handling complaints related to Public Works Department activities.

Section 8 repeals Kitsap County Code Section 2.108 in its entirety.

Section 9 repeals Kitsap County Code Section 11.04.020.

Section 10 repeals Kitsap County Code Section 11.04.030.

Section 11 amends Kitsap County Code Section 11.16.020, "Work for other public agencies", to establish policy and procedure for undertaking work for other public agencies.

Section 12 amends Kitsap County Code Section 46.44.0904, "Special permits for extra oversize", to update insurance requirements and reference permit fee section of KCC 21.06.

Section 13 amends Kitsap County Code Section 46.44.0941, "Fees" to reference appropriate RCW.

Section 14 repeals Kitsap County Resolution No. 603-1979, Section 2.

This ordinance provides for the severability of any invalid part.

This ordinance will take effect immediately upon adoption by the Kitsap County Board of Commissioners.
