Wanted!

Criminal solicitation for kidnapping and outstanding warrants

Port Orchard, Wash. – The Kitsap County Sheriff's Office, together with the Port Orchard Police Department, is seeking assistance from the general public in locating a warrant subject who is also wanted in conjunction with criminal solicitation for 1st degree kidnapping.

Name: **Duane Michael Sloan**, age 33, formerly of North Kitsap. Sloan's current whereabouts are unknown. Sloan is known to frequent Poulsbo, Suquamish, Kingston and South Kitsap.

Description: 6' 02" ht. 210 – 220 lbs. wt. black hair hazel eyes

Sloan's head is usually shaved. He has a tattoo on his right shoulder in the image of a devil, and a tattoo on his left shoulder in the image of a joker.

Outstanding warrants:

- Kitsap County Superior Court warrant of arrest for felony eluding. Issued: 01/29/2007. Bail: \$25,000.
- Poulsbo Municipal Court misdemeanor warrant of arrest for driving while license suspended / revoked, 1st degree. Issued: 02/07/2007. Bail: \$15,000.
- Kitsap County District Court misdemeanor warrant of arrest for possession of drug paraphernalia. Issued: 01/25/2007. Bail: \$5,000.

Sloan is also wanted for questioning in an investigation into criminal solicitation for kidnapping. The solicitation involves an allegation of a scheme to kidnap two children, in order to prevent their mother from testifying against two defendants who are presently in custody facing charges of kidnapping and assault, 1st degree (deadly weapon).
