Man found dead following apparent domestic dispute

Kingston, Wash. -- Kitsap County Sheriff's deputies and detectives are presently at the scene of an apparent domestic violence homicide, at a residence in the 25000 block of South Kingston Road NE, Kingston.

Found deceased at the location was an adult male aged in his early 50s. Taken into custody by sheriff's deputies is a second adult male, age 21. They are believed to be father and son.

The report was received at Kitsap County Central Communications at 4:48 p.m. and dispatched to patrol deputies within seconds. Sheriff's deputies were on scene within minutes, followed by medic units from North Kitsap Fire & Rescue. Deputies set containment and then tactically approached the residence, first finding the deceased man and, within moments, the alleged suspect. The deceased man appeared to have died from violent means. The alleged suspect was taken into custody without further incident.

Sheriff's detectives are processing the residence and property to collect evidence, document the scene and interview possible witnesses.

The suspect has been transported to the main sheriff's office in Port Orchard for questioning by detectives.

The name of the deceased man will be released publicly upon confirmation of his identity by the Kitsap County Coroner's Office and following notification of family members. The cause and manner of death will be determined by the Kitsap County Coroner.
