Update

Robbery suspects now in custody

Port Orchard, Wash. -- Three persons wanted in connection with the alleged armed robbery and assault of a 35 year-old Central Kitsap man, are now in custody after voluntarily surrendering to a sheriff's detective yesterday.

The alleged suspects, Rachel Lynn Barron, 22, of Poulsbo; Kyle Lawrence Kailani Hoapili, 24, formerly of Lakewood, Wash., and Gerald Abraham Tavares V, 23, of Bremerton, were taken into custody in the lobby of the Kitsap County Sheriff's Office in Port Orchard. The trio walked into the sheriff's office shortly after 3:00 p.m.

The alleged robbery and assault occurred around 7:45 p.m. Thursday, Oct. 18, on NW Jessie Mae Lane, off of Sesame Street NW, in Central Kitsap west of Silverdale.

According to the victim, he had made previous arrangements to meet Barron for a date. The victim stated that while both were seated inside of his vehicle a window of his truck was suddenly shattered and both doors were yanked open.

The victim stated that Barron jumped out of the vehicle followed immediately by Hoapili and Tavares entering the truck on each side. The victim alleges that the two males started beating him, demanding money, his wallet and a cellular telephone. At some point, according to the victim, one of the two produced a handgun. The victim claimed that the two men then pulled him out of his vehicle and beat him to the ground, using the handgun as a club.

After removing a stereo out of his truck the three suspects fled in another vehicle.

Following their surrender, Barron and Tavares were booked into Kitsap County Jail for robbery, 1st degree, with bail set at \$250,000. Hoapili was booked into jail for robbery, 1st degree, and for unlawful possession of a firearm, with bail set at \$350,000.

All three are scheduled to make an initial appearance in Kitsap County Superior Court at 3:00 p.m. today.
