## Arrest made in espresso stand burglaries

**Port Orchard, Wash.** -- Kitsap County Sheriff's detectives have one person now in custody on suspicion of multiple burglaries to espresso stands in various jurisdictions within the county.

A 20 year-old South Kitsap man was taken into custody this morning at his family's residence. He was interviewed by investigators and booked into the Kitsap County Jail on ten counts of burglary, 2<sup>nd</sup> degree. His bail was set at \$50,000.

Additional arrests may be possible.

Detectives developed information that the suspect is responsible for the nighttime burglaries that occurred between June 2008 – Oct. 5, 2008, in the following areas:

- Two in the City of Bremerton.
- One in the unincorporated area of East Bremerton.
- Three in the City of Port Orchard.
- Four in the unincorporated area of South Kitsap.

Investigators also believe that this suspect burglarized an espresso stand in Mason County. Information on this burglary has been forwarded to Mason County Sheriff's Office.

Evidence obtained during the investigation included interior security surveillance system video footage that provided details of the suspect's clothing and physical characteristics. Port Orchard Police Department assisted in this case with investigative leads.

According to investigative records, there have been more than 25 espresso stand burglaries that have occurred within the past several months. Investigations continue into the cases still open.

The suspect in today's arrest is scheduled to make his initial appearance in Kitsap County Superior Court tomorrow at 3:00 p.m.
