Elderly woman missing from South Kitsap

Port Orchard, Wash. -- The Kitsap County Sheriff's Office is requesting the assistance of regional media and the general public in trying to find a senior citizen missing for the past ten (+) hours from her residence in South Kitsap.

Dorothy Moudry Brown, age 75, was last seen by her family at 11:45 a.m. today, as she drove away from the family residence.

Brown suffers from severe dementia. She is under the care of her stepdaughter and resides with the family at 3538 Harper Hill Road SE. While family members were preparing for a daytime shopping trip Brown left the residence unnoticed and drove away in a family vehicle:

- 2004 Honda CRV
- Color: silver & gray
- License: 833-SWU (WA)

Eyes: blue **Hair:** curly gray

Clothing: unknown

The family reports that Brown is not from Kitsap County and is unfamiliar with the area. The vehicle is equipped with a WSDOT "Good to Go" decal on the windshield. A check with WSDOT indicates that the vehicle has not crossed the Tacoma Narrows Bridge since Brown left. The vehicle carries an antenna ball in the shape of a moose head on the vehicle's radio antenna.
