In the early morning hours of Saturday, Oct. 31, 2009, Paymela Faye Long was found deceased in the remains of her burned, single-wide pre-manufactured home in the Illahee Shores Mobile Home Park, 4330 Illahee Rd NE in East Bremerton. An autopsy revealed that Paymela had died of homicidal violence. Crime Stoppers of Puget Sound and the Kitsap County Sheriff's Office are seeking any information in this case.
