FOOD SCRAPS

- Meat, fish, or poultry
- Eggs & dairy products
- Fruits
- Vegetables
- Breads, pasta, and grains
- Nutshells
- Coffee grounds/filters & Tea bags
- Plate scrapings



PAPER

- Shredded paper
- Paper towels and napkins
- Egg cartons (non-styrofoam)
- Pizza boxes



PLANTS & WOOD

- Grass and leaves
- Weeds
- Prunings
- Branches (under 4' long, 4" diameter)
- Vegetable garden waste
- Houseplants



NO

- Cooking oil and grease
- Plastic bags
- Plastic food wrap
- Plastic containers
- Metal and glass
- Car grease or liquids
- Diapers
- Pet litter or waste
- Soil and rocks
- Sod
- Stumps
- Branches over 4' x 4"
- Lumber or fencing
- Hazardous waste
- Household garbage

Curbside yard waste collection is convenient and saves you a trip to a facility - saving both time and fuel. Composting organics produces less greenhouse gas emissions than landfilling, and keeps valuable materials in the recycling loop.
