Order Requirements

Orders may be placed in person, by email or fax to the Auditor's Office Elections Division and may need three days to complete.

Affidavit: A signed affidavit that voter information will not be used for commercial purposes.

Payment: There is no fee for voter data sent by email. Payment must be received for orders requiring a fee before the order is filled (\$5.00 fee if the order is mailed).
