**City of Bremerton  
Proposition No. 1  
Property Tax Limit Increase**

The City Council of the City of Bremerton approved [Resolution No. 3032](#) concerning an increase in the City's regular property tax levy. This proposition provides funding for maintenance and operations of parks facilities; implementation of a community improvement program; improving and constructing sidewalks; and renovation, improvement and development of neighborhood parks. This proposition authorizes the City to increase its regular property tax levy for collection in 2008 to \$2.12 per thousand dollars of assessed value and increase the levy as allowed by chapter RCW 84.55 for each of the five succeeding years to fund these programs.
