- **Web Reports:** available at www.kitsapgov.com/aud. Beginning 2002 all official election results are available on the Kitsap County website. Beginning 2003 results by precinct were also added to the options.

Previous to 2002: For 1998 through 2001, the Primary and General election official results are listed on the Kitsap County website. Please contact the Elections Division for any election results not listed on our website or if you have any questions.
- **CD or Disk copies:** 1998 through 2001 official election results are available in a text file by race and/or by precinct, for a fee of \$5.00.
- **Hard Copies:** A fee of \$.15 per page is charged for paper copies of election results.
- **State Wide Statistics:** State wide election results are now available online for elections from 1990 to current date. That website is www.secstate.wa.gov/elections.

Order Requirements:

An Affidavit: Required on all orders with a signature stating that the information will not be used for commercial purposes. (RCW 29A.08.730)

Payment: Required when the order is placed.

Order Available: As agreed, however, three days may be needed to complete an order.

Mailing Fee: \$5.00 applies if the order requires mailing.

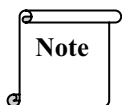

Copy and Map Orders:

- **Copies:** Copies are \$.15 each page.
- **Maps:** Maps are \$10.00 for District Maps which are up to 34 x 44 inches, \$2.50 for size 11 x 17 inches. Individual Precinct Maps are \$.15 and are 8 ½ x 11 inches.
