RESOLUTION 09-02AUDITOR/ELECTIONS
KITSAP COUNTYPAGE 1 OF 2**EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES LEVY REQUEST TO VOTERS (6-YEAR LEVY)**

A resolution of the Board of Commissioners of Central Kitsap Fire & Rescue (also referred to herein as "District"), providing for submission to the qualified electors of the District, at an election to be held within the District on **May 19, 2009**, a proposition authorizing the continuation of a levy of a regular property tax in the sum of \$.50 per \$1,000 assessed valuation each year for six consecutive years, to be levied each year succeeding the year of the levy, to provide funds required by the District to enable it to provide emergency medical services in accordance with the laws of the State of Washington, RCW 84.52.069.

WHEREAS: It is the judgment of the Board of Commissioners of the District that it is essential and necessary for the protection of the health and life of the residents of the District that the emergency medical services enumerated in this resolution be provided by the District. Such services will necessitate the expenditure of revenues for maintenance, operations and equipment.

THEREFORE: Be it resolved by the Board of Fire Commissioners of Central Kitsap Fire & Rescue, Washington as follows:

Section 1. The District shall provide emergency medical care or emergency medical services, including related personnel costs, training for such personnel, and related equipment, supplies, vehicles and structures needed for the provision of emergency medical care or emergency medical services.

Section 2. In order to produce the revenue adequate to pay the costs of providing life protection services as described in Section 1 of this resolution and assure the continuation of such services, the District shall levy for six consecutive years, beginning in 2009, and collect such levy each year for a period of six consecutive years, beginning in 2010, a general tax on taxable property within the District, maintenance and operation costs in the amount of \$.50 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation.

Section 3. There shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the District for their ratification or rejection at an election on **May 19, 2009**, the question of whether or not such levy for maintenance and operation shall be made.

Section 4. The Auditor of Kitsap County, Washington as ex-officio supervisor of elections is requested to submit the attached proposition, "APPENDIX A", to the District's voters at the May 19, 2009 election:




