**RESOLUTION NO. 2009/2010-05
FOUR-YEAR SCHOOL SUPPORT LEVIES**

ADD TO ELECTIONS
KITSAP COUNTY

WHEREAS, the money in and to be paid into the General Fund of Bremerton School District No. 100-C, Kitsap County, Washington (the "District"), during the 2010-2011, 2011-2012, 2012-2013, 2013-2014 and 2014-2015 school years, will be insufficient to enable the District to take care of all of its necessary financial obligations and to properly meet the educational needs of students attending District schools; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide for such financial obligations and educational needs, it is deemed necessary that additional taxes in the amounts set forth herein be levied for the District's General Fund upon all of the taxable property within the District in excess of the maximum annual tax levy permitted by law without a vote of electors; and

WHEREAS, the constitution and laws of the State of Washington require that the question of whether or not such taxes may be levied must be submitted to the qualified electors of the District for their ratification or rejection;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of Bremerton School District No. 100-C, Kitsap County, Washington as follows:

1. Declaration of Need: It is hereby found and declared that the welfare of the students and other residents of the District requires the District to carry out the plans described herein to pay part of the general expenses of the operation and maintenance of the District.
2. Levy of Taxes: In order to provide funds for educational programs and for the operation and maintenance of the District as described in Section 3 below, the following taxes for the District's General Fund should be levied upon all of the taxable property within the District in excess of the maximum annual tax levy permitted by law to be levied for the District without a vote of the electors:

** 2010 Voter approved Levy amount is \$10,561,000 for the previous 2007-2010 Levy

The excess taxes identified above replace the expiring maintenance and operation levies that were previously authorized by the voters of the District.

3. Voter Approval; Use of Funds: Upon approval by the District's voters of the ballot proposition described in Section 4 below, the District may use the proceeds of the levies to pay such part of the general expenses of educational programs, maintenance, and operation of the District as may be authorized or allowed by law for the use of excess levy funds, and to repay warrants or other lawful indebtedness incurred to defray such expenses.
4. Declaration of Emergency; Election: It is hereby found and declared that an emergency exists requiring the submission of the proposition of whether or not such excess taxes should be levied for ratification or rejection by the qualified electors of the District, at a special election to be held on February 9, 2010. The Kitsap County Auditor, as ex officio supervisor of elections in said county, is hereby requested to also find the existence of such emergency and to call and conduct the special election to be held within the District on said date and to submit to the qualified electors of the District the proposition set forth below. The Secretary of the Board of Directors is hereby authorized and directed to certify the proposition in the following form:

PROPOSITION NO. 1
SCHOOL SUPPORT LEVY**

To renew an expiring levy and meet the educational needs of students in Bremerton School District No. 100-C, shall the District levy the following taxes upon all taxable property within the District for the purpose of

- supporting educational programs and
- providing school operation and maintenance funds

for four years:






