Part 1: Advisory Group Purpose/Mission Statement

The mission of the Kitsap County Arts Board is to promote excellence, access, education and diversity in the arts, in order to improve the quality of life for all Kitsap Residents.

Part 2: Accomplishments in 2008

- A. Purchased \$2000 worth of artwork to start the Rotating Art Collection to be used in public spaces within the Kitsap County offices.
- B. Completed the artist selections for the Coroner's Facility which should be completed by June 2009.
- C. Worked with, and satisfactorily resolved the hanging of the thirteen (13) photographs for the Teen Grant Photo Project. These pieces are displayed on the 2nd floor of the Kitsap County Courthouse.
- D. Completed the hanging of the artwork for the Juror room in the Kitsap County Courthouse.
- E. Placed Rotating Art Collection in the newly renovated Public Works Building.
- F. Supported the America's Recycle Day sponsored by Public Works. Board Members volunteered time by displaying student posters in the Max Hale Building located in Bremerton.
- G. Transitions:
 - Two Board members took seats, both in December 2008.
 - Two original Board members retired after 3+ years, their last meeting being in December.
