City of Bremerton

(Census Tracts – 801.01, 801.02, 802.00, 803.00, 805.00, 806.00, 807.00, 810.00, 811.00, 812.00, 814.00)

Public Services

- Bremerton Foodline* – Provided funds for perishable and non-perishable food supplies and sundries to Kitsap County.
- Bremerton Services Association* - Provided funds for nutritious meals to low-income elderly persons in Kitsap County.
- Catholic Community Services – Provided funds for Benedict House, an emergency and transitional housing facility for homeless men.
- Kitsap Community Resources (KCR)* - Provided funds for emergency and transitional housing programs for homeless families in Kitsap County.
- Literacy Council of Kitsap* - Provided funds for adult reading and life skill instruction for Kitsap County residents.
- RMH Services* – Provided funds for access to mental health case management and psychiatric services for the chronically mentally ill.
- YMCA* - Provided funds for childcare scholarships to enable low-income children to attend Latchkey childcare programs.
- YWCA* - Provided funds for family outreach services to families who are at-risk for abuse and neglect.

Capital Projects

- Kitsap Community Resources (KCR) - Provided funds to construct the Bremerton Services Center, a “green” office building that houses many of KCR’s services including Employment and Education, Americorps, Women, Infants and Children (WIC), Kitchen Services and agency administration.
- Habitat for Humanity – Provided funds to construct 5 affordable single family homes for low to very low income families.
- Kitsap County Consolidated Housing Authority (KCCHA) – Provided funds for Down Payment Assistance to 4 families with incomes at 80% or below Kitsap MFI.

South Kitsap County

Public Services

- Kitsap Sexual Assault Center* - Provided funds for child abuse intervention services including crisis intervention and legal and medical advocacy.
- West Sound Treatment Center* - Provided funds for chemical treatment services for working poor patients of Kitsap County.

Capital Projects

- Kitsap Community Resources (KCR) – Provided funds to the KCR Weatherization Program to weatherize 24 low-income homes in South Kitsap County.
- Kitsap County Consolidated Housing Authority (KCCHA) – Provided funds for KCCHA’s Home Rehab program to rehabilitate 4 low-income homes in South Kitsap County.
- Kitsap County Consolidated Housing Authority (KCCHA) – Provided funds for Down Payment Assistance to 2 families with incomes at 80% or below Kitsap MFI.

Capital Projects

- Kitsap Community Resources (KCR) – Provided funds to the KCR Weatherization Program to weatherize 22 low-income homes in Central Kitsap County.
- Kitsap County Consolidated Housing Authority (KCCHA) – Provided funds for KCCHA's Home Rehab program to rehabilitate 2 low-income homes in Central Kitsap County.

North Kitsap County

(Census tracts – 905.00, 902.00, 906.01, 901.01, 901.02, 906.02, 907.00, 908.00, 909.00, 910.00)

Capital Projects

- Housing Resources Board (HRB) – Provided funds to pay for the construction of Island Home, a 10 unit family transitional housing project located on Bainbridge Island that provides affordable housing to low-income families.
- Kitsap Community Resources (KCR) – Provided funds to the KCR Weatherization Program to weatherize 3 low-income homes in North Kitsap County.
- Habitat for Humanity- Provided funds to construct 1 affordable single family home for a low to very low income family.
- Kitsap County Consolidated Housing Authority (KCCHA) – Provided funds for Down Payment Assistance to 21 families with incomes at 80% or below Kitsap MFI.
- Kitsap County Consolidated Housing Authority (KCCHA) – Provided funds for the acquisition of Finch Place Apartments, a 29 unit apartment complex serving very low income seniors located on Bainbridge Island
- Housing Resources Board (HRB) – Provided funds for the acquisition & preservation of 48 units of affordable rental housing on Bainbridge Island.
