

## KITSAP COUNTY DISTRICT COURT

### PAYMENT OPTION INFORMATION SHEET

All fines, fees and costs ordered are due and payable today.

If you cannot pay in full today, you must see the clerk to arrange for a payment option, as follows:

- You may request up to sixty days to pay your obligation in full. This extension is for one time only; or
- A time pay contract with a private contractor (Court Payment Management Services -CPMS). This service will require you to pay a set up fee, monthly service fees, and a per month interest cost. (The clerk has the application and information sheet regarding this service.); or
- Community Service Work may be performed as payment based on the current State minimum wage. You must provide proof of your income, such as a current paystub and last year's tax return, or current status of income from Employment Security.

No other payment options are available or shall be granted by the court. If you fail to make payment on criminal cases, the entire balance of the fine and/or cost will become due. This account will be referred to a collection agency per RCW 19.16.500 and you will be responsible for any and all collection costs.

Failure to make payment on traffic infractions shall result in an additional fail to respond penalty added as mandated by rule and law. The matter additionally shall be referred to a collection agency per RCW 19.16.500 and you shall be liable for any and all collection costs. Failure to pay a traffic related infraction shall result in the suspension of your driver's license by the Department of Licensing until ALL penalties required by rule or law have been paid.


