

KITSAP COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN 10-YEAR UPDATE VOLUME II: DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT



Errata Sheet

On August 29, 2006, Kitsap County completed a draft Comprehensive Plan update to meet the community’s refined vision and requirements of the Washington state Growth Management Act (GMA). The draft Comprehensive Plan was updated to address a new 2025 planning horizon and associated population targets. The proposed amendments include Comprehensive Land Use Plan amendments in unincorporated areas in Kitsap County, including unincorporated Urban Growth Areas (UGAs). The proposed amendments also include policy amendments, capital facilities plan and proposed development regulations. The intent of this errata matrix is to organize any corrections that need to be resolved in the final Environmental Impact Statement. Elements of the DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT (Volume II) include existing conditions inventory, associated analysis of impacts to all three proposed alternatives and mitigation measures, as well as reasonable measures assessment and quantification. Additional errata’s are also compiled for both Volume I and Volume III.
