Meeting Minutes

May 16, 2007

I. Call to order

President Jon Pearson called to order the regular meeting of the **Central Kitsap Community Council** at **7:00 p.m.** on **May 16, 2007** in the **Evergreen Room, Silverdale Community Center.**

II. Roll call

Council members introduced themselves. The following persons were present: Natalie Bryson, Mary Earl, Carl Johnson, Tex Lewis, Robert Moyer, Jon Pearson, Dave Peterson, Richard Shattuck, Carol Smiley and Roger Zabinski. Also present were Commissioner Josh Brown and staff member Joyce E.S. Figueroa de Raschke.

III. Approval of minutes from last meeting and adoption of agenda

The minutes from the meeting of April 18, 2007, were approved as presented. The agenda was adopted as presented.

IV. Correspondence/Announcements

Jon Pearson announced notice of a public hearing for Rite-Aid in Silverdale, and discussed his participation in the “Kitsap Cares about Kids” program.

Commissioner Brown announced that the Silverdale Design Guidelines had been adopted, and expressed his disappointment at the Library Levy Lid failure. He also discussed the budgetary challenges facing Kitsap County and the process for selecting a new Commissioner for North Kitsap County.

V. New business

- a) **Commissioner Brown** stated that Chip Faver, the new Facilities, Parks and Recreation Director will be introduced at a later meeting.
- b) **Commissioner Brown** gave a presentation on the parking and transportation issues in Old Town Silverdale. A written report is in the CKCC file.
- c) **Jim Aho** provided a report on the Illahee Community, including the impacts associated with Urban Growth Areas on natural resources. He also discussed the Illahee Forest Stewardship Committee’s activities.

VI. Committee reports

- a) **Community & Government Relations**: Commissioner Brown noted that Representative Jay Inslee had tasked a member of his District Office to try and assist with the Seabeck Marina project.

- b) **Parks & Environment**: Roger Zablinski discussed the variety of Earth Day activities within Kitsap and Mason Counties, and the “I Spy” trail walk at the Clear Creek Trail. Natalie Bryson announced the Silverdale Rotary’s held with wheelchair access at the Old Mill site, and a celebration of Paul Brittan’s life at the Clear Creek Trail Interpretive Center on August 26, 2007.
