### **A. Land Use & Economic Development**

- **Jack Hamilton** discussed the Resolution regarding the average 3 units per acre, CAC May 11, 2006 – BOCC Urban Land Use Designation from 5 to 9 (bright line), to 4 to 9 w/sewer. Not in Silverdale Planning Process. Argument needs to go to Olympia with the backing of the Board.

### **B. Transportation**

- **Naomi Pursel** stated that the Central Kitsap Fire & Rescue's local "Kid's Day" will be held on June 10, 2006 from 10:00 AM – 2:30 PM at the Fairgrounds. Safe Routes Program scheduling talks with the Central Kitsap School District regarding mechanisms to identify funding for infrastructure for the 1 mile radius to encourage students, and adults to walk. Fair Days are coming, another chance to pitch the Community Campus.

### **C. Parks & Environment**

- **Tex Lewis** described the photographic exhibit from the WA State Historical Society entitled "*Captured Time--Photographic Moments of Discovery in the Northwest*" and a small collection of antique cameras and photography equipment" displayed at the Clear Creek/Saq'ad Interpretive Center.
- **Mary Earl** mentioned the National Trail Day and Auction on June 3, 2006, and gave the website, [Clear Creek Trail@yahoo.com](mailto:ClearCreekTrail@yahoo.com).
- **Sue Fox** stated trash was removed from the old shed by the homestead. CKHS students installed two small bridges with materials provided by Park Department grant funds, and a donation from Nicole Boand. Next work party scheduled for June 7, 2006 at 6:30 PM – 8:30 PM. Quarterly meeting scheduled at the Silverdale Fire Station for July 25, 2006 from 7:00 PM – 9:00 PM.

- **Commissioner Lent** responded to this resolution:

- b. The rescinded sewer hook-up ordinance along Chico Way is being rewritten by legal, and should be available this summer.
  - c. Announced 2 architectural firms are providing a cost proposal for the Community Campus Master Plan.
  - d. Reminded the council that several Silverdale roads and arterials are under construction this summer.
  - e. Promoted the Leadership Kitsap Sailing school kickoff at Silverdale Waterfront Park on June 3, 2006 from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM.
