

# CENTRAL KITSAP COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEETING

1. **Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order by President Hank Mann-Sykes.

  - B. **Meeting Summary:** M/S/C to approve the May meeting summary.
  - C. **Adoption of Agenda:** M/S/C to adopt the agenda as presented.
  - D. **Correspondence/Announcements:**
    1. **Hank Mann-Sykes** read the email from Tex Lewis regarding the vandalism on the Clear Creek Trail. Mary Earl stated that about one month ago that the metal tool shed double doors was vandalized at the new Ridge Top Pavilion – replacement cost is \$800.00. Recommended emphasis patrol and not random patrol checks from the Kitsap County Sheriff’s Department.
    2. **Hank Mann-Sykes** 50 emails on Alternative #2 on the CAC meetings, and have been forwarded on to the Commissioner’s office. The Harper family appeared with concerns to discuss this.
2. **Special Presentation:**
  - A. **10-year Update to the Comprehensive Plan:**
    - **Angie Silva and Eric Baker/Department of Community Development** gave an update on the 10-year review of the County’s Comprehensive Plan. General questions routed to Eric Baker or Angie Silva. (Written report in file.)
    - **Jim Aho/Citizens Advisory Group – Illahee Community Plan** gave a presentation from the Illahee Citizens Advisory Group on the initial draft of the Illahee Community Plan. (Written report in file.)
3. **Reports/Updates:**
  - A. **Community & Government Relations**
    - **Joyce E. S. Figueroa de Raschke gave report from Commissioner Lent.** (Written report in file.) Natalie Bryson inquired about the lighting situation update on Illich Road since Silverdale Water District is laying piping in that area.
    - **Hank Mann-Sykes** stated that the Community Campus Task Force was merged into

the Community Committee and meeting will begin the second week in July.

## **B. Parks & Environment**

- **Coreen Johnson/Clear Creek Trail** discussed and submitted the new Clear Creek Trail Map and Interpretive Guide, Old Towne Silverdale Walking Map, and Kitsap Peninsula's Heritage Guide.
  - a. Stated the Clear Creek Trail interruptions are due to the County's road projects.
  - b. Fundraisers: garage sale/rummage sale, and email silent auction to raise money to celebrate "National Trails Day" on June 3, 2006. Goal was to make \$4,500. they made \$4,400.
  - c. Mentioned the vandalism from spring until present (to the trail, Ridge Top Pavilion metal tool shed, picnic table fire, and the Old Home Site), and possible deterrents/reward (Crime Stoppers, etc.).
  - d. **Natalie Bryson** stated that the Council needs to be clear that vandalism is not acceptable, and that they will be held accountable. Joe Clark/Stand Up For Kids might be a contact to get the word out.
  - e. **Jack Hamilton** stated that he will talk with Sheriff Boyer about patrolling options.
  - f. Mentioned the traveling "*Historical Photography Exhibit*" on loan from the Washington State Historical Society every Wednesday, and every other Saturday and Sunday through the end of July.

## **C. Transportation**

- **Kay Wilson** filled in for Naomi Pursel. She reminded the Council about the County Fair in August, and asked what the emphasis should be for the booth. Naomi Pursel suggested the Sub-Area Plan Process, and wanted to know if other County departments will be at the fair (especially Public Works to discuss all of the transportation projects going on). The Transportation Committee is working on the "Safe Routes to School" project. They are looking for volunteers to get a County-wide grant proposal for more than just our area, to be a Committee member.
