2. **Business Meeting:**
 - **Jon Pearson brought the Review and Vote on Letter to Library Board (Attachment A) before the Council: M/S/C** to approve letter. (Written report in file.)
 - **Jon Pearson read the First Reading of Amendment to Bylaws (Attachment B):** to the Central Kitsap Community Council on Article V Representation for nomination for a U.S. Navy representative by the Naval Submarine Base Bangor Commanding Officer: **M/S/C** to approve Article V as presented. (Written report in file.)
 - **Jon Pearson announced the Introduction and Public Presentation of Community Campus Alternatives by Rice, Fergus, Miller Architecture & Planning Committee Reports.** (Written report in file.)
 - 1) **Steve Rice and Bob Hutchinson** presented the Silverdale Community Campus Alternatives #1 and #4.
 - Discussed the Master Plan objective and preservation of what the community holds most dear.
 - **Hank Mann-Sykes** stated that a brick promenade on Poplars to the Mall had previously been discussed.
 - Facilitate the ease of getting the public into the area, signalized walks, and the roundabout has to be pedestrian friendly.
 - Potential phasing strategy since the development will be over time, and not all at once. The Silverdale Community Campus design will be placed on-site for the community to track.
 - **Gary Lindsey** suggested using a platform building over Poplars.
 - **Hank Mann-Sykes** inquired about the use of sky bridges.

- **Roger Zabinski** asked if either Mill Creek or Spokane County had been looked at for their layout, and trail systems.
- Both public and private funds will need to be utilized for this project.
- **Hank Mann-Sykes** stated that the Ray Frocks foundation about six months ago had given their first grant in Seattle (modeled after Vancouver, WA).
- Mike Walton stated that a funding source within a year for a full service YMCA. Support from the community with serving a big investment.
- **Gary Lindsey** suggested showing the budget to the public for the various community areas.

A. Community & Government Relations:

- **Commissioner Josh W. Brown** stated that he envisions a multitude of partners for the Silverdale Community Campus. The Library Board is meeting tonight to discuss the amount for the Library LID lift and to include it in the bond process in May. Kitsap County will be partnering with other Silverdale Community Campus developers. Identified the differences between suburban (surface parking) and urban (more open spaces) that the community wants. Kitsap County will work with public building occupants as the process evolves with relocation options in: the Kitsap County Sheriff's Silverdale Precinct Office; the Poplars - Kitsap County Consolidated Housing Authority Senior Housing (in the next 10 to 12 years); and the Silverdale Community Center (District Court, Head Start, Kitsap Community Resources, Central Stage Theatre of County Kitsap, and optional meeting rooms).
