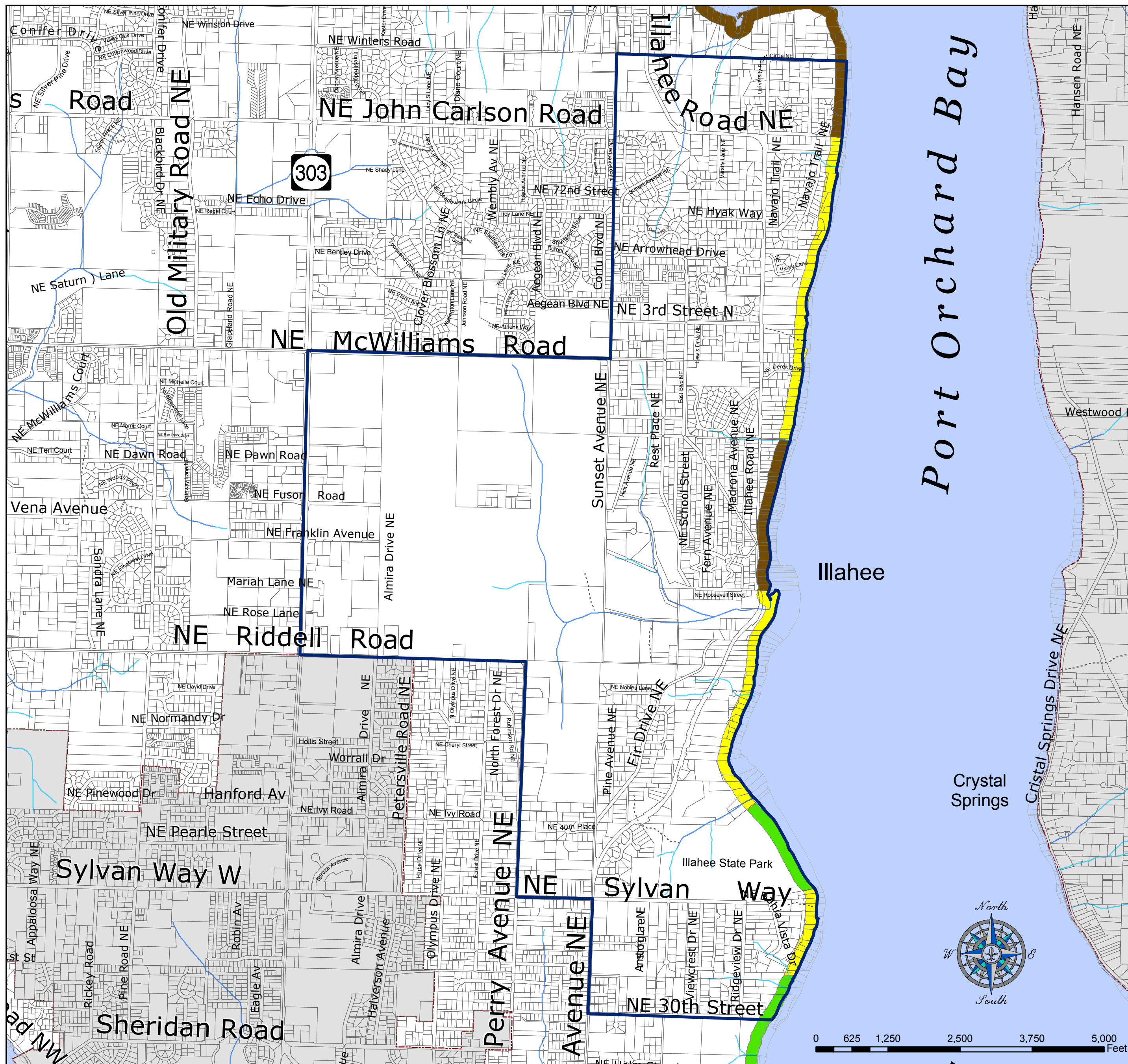

Conservancy

The objective of the conservancy environment is to protect, conserve and manage existing natural resources and valuable historic and cultural areas. This designation ensures a continuous flow of recreational benefits to the public and achieves sustained resource utilization. It will also protect fish and wildlife habitat and environmentally sensitive areas. A sub-environment has been designated for Conservancy areas, which are publicly owned and dedicated for use and enjoyment as a park, recreational site or open space.

Rural

The purpose of the rural environment is to:

- protect agricultural land from urban expansion,
- restrict intensive development along undeveloped shorelines,
- function as a buffer between urban areas and
- maintain open spaces and opportunities for recreational uses compatible with agricultural and forestry uses.

Semi-Rural

The intent of the semi-rural environment is to promote a multiple-use shoreline area in which the scale of uses fall between that of the rural and urban environments. Certain aspects of the natural environment will be retained in conjunction with permitted uses.
