PROCEEDINGS:

Opening:

- The meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm. Chairperson Kevin McDonald provided an overview of SCAC's purpose, members, and staff for those in attendance.
- The September minutes were reviewed and approved.
- Kevin McDonald reviewed the program and agenda for the meeting.

Correspondence:

- Tom Curley reported on an announcement for a Trails Conference in Yakima on November 3-4.

Program:

- Bill Zupancicof and Terry Reckord provided an overview of the Mosquito Fleet Trail Master Plan. Under the State Scenic Byways Program, this plan would make the Mosquito Fleet Trail a Heritage Tour Route. The Trail extends 57 miles along roadways from Southworth to West Kingston. The goals of the project are to secure funding and ultimately to attract tourism and disseminate the story of the Mosquito Fleet. - Using maps of the Suquamish village area, Eric Schmidt discussed several options resulting from the Rural Corridor Study that would accommodate pedestrian sidewalks, curbs, and bicycle lanes along Augusta and Division Streets—including the challenges and advantages of each option. The presentation was followed by a question and answer period and distribution of a questionnaire to solicit attendee's opinions regarding roadway features they consider highest priority.
