Agenda Review

Pete announced the Hansville Community Planning page is up and running on the County web site. Pete demonstrated on his laptop how to access the site and the information the site contains. The County will be responsible to keep the site updated with information. A guest commented that the County web site is not user friendly and he's only aware of the fact that there is a web site because he attended the Planning Meeting. He requested the community be notified how to find the information regarding the Community Plan.

In response to this comment – Art Ellison announced he would create a link to the County web site from the [Hansville.org](http://www.hansville.org) site.

A committee member commented that the Meeting Agenda was available May 13th, however, it had not posted to the web site by the day of the meeting. Her concern was that the community would not know what the meeting was about and whether or not they should attend based on the issues being discussed.

In response to this comment – Art (webmaster for [Hansville.org](http://www.hansville.org)) stated the Agenda was posted. (After the meeting it was confirmed that the Agenda was mistakenly posted elsewhere on the site.) Suggest that at the next Planning meeting we develop a procedure that insures documents are posted in a manner that is more timely and correct.

Hansville Community Plan Elements/Visioning Exercise

Pete reviewed the Planning Process (see attached graphic)

A committee member voiced concern regarding public awareness about the Planning Process.

In response to this comment – Jim Bolger said information would be given to the community at the Open House.

A committee member voiced concern about current community issues not being discussed (i.e., parks, OPG, vineyard, etc.).

In response to this comment – Jim Bolger stated the issues mentioned are not the purpose of the Planning Group. The Planning Group is to focus only on long range (20 year) planning and recommended the GHAAC will focus on any eminent issues facing the community.

A committee member asked Jim Bolger for clarification regarding the tabling of Tony Atkinson's Community Impact Issues Resolution at the May 13 GHAAC meeting, as Linda Reidling wished to address an idea related to the Community Planning Committee and the revising of the new resolution. Jim Bolger responded that he had not been approached regarding this idea since the GHAAC meeting.

The question was then addressed to Linda Redling.

In response - Linda Redling declined to comment.

A committee member asked if the Publicity Committee would continue to function.

In response to this comment – Jim Bolger and Pete Sullivan agreed that the Publicity Committee would continue to function (writing press releases, determining various methods of media, etc.).

Jim Bolger reviewed the various Plan Elements – Hansville's Futures Elements were compared to the Community Plans from Keyport, Suquamish, Manchester. Jim then separated the committee into two separate groups to discuss writing "vision" statements for 4 Plan Elements (land use, economic development, parks/recreation, environment). The two groups reunited to discuss the elements covered in each visioning exercise. Jim and Pete will now develop these vision statements further for review at the next Planning Meeting.

A committee member voiced concern about working on a village plan. He would like to start another committee to focus strictly on developing a village plan.

In response to this comment – Jim Bolger stated the Planning Committee is working on a Comprehensive Plan that encompasses the entire community, which will include the village/downtown area. He pointed out the community needs to determine if they want Hansville to develop into a "destination" community " or remain a commuter/bedroom community.

Meeting adjourned at 9:30 pm.
