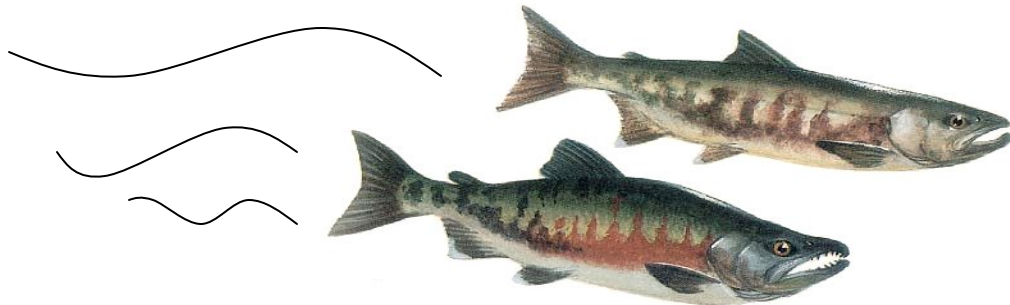


SPOOKY SALMON

Salmon Stewards are trained volunteers that share their knowledge with the public as they gather at local stream banks to watch the amazing spectacle of salmon returning to spawn.

This introductory four-hour course will cover the basics of salmon ecology, including identification, habitat, and life-cycle. The first two hours will be in-class on October 17th from 10-12 at Silverdale's Clear Creek Interpretive Center. The second two hours of the training will be in-the-field at one of two Salmon Tours locations (Chico or Dogfish Creeks, your choice) from 10-12 on Saturday, October 31st.

Salmon Stewards will then arrange to be at these two locations for at least a couple of hours each Saturday in November. Depending on the number of Stewards, this may be as little as a two hour commitment for one Saturday.
