

## **Birding at Illahee Forest Preserve**

### *“Songs of the Forest”*

Idie Ulsh will be leading birding walks thru Illahee Forest Preserve this spring which will focus upon sounds of forest birds. Idie Ulsh is a Master Birder and past president of Seattle Audubon. Idie is remarkable with her abilities to bird by ear. The walk will be a 2 mile stroll on relatively level ground along Forest trails. Bring binoculars. Bird books optional.

During our April 19th walk we saw/heard 23 species of birds in Illahee Forest Preserve. We expect various warblers will have returned to Illahee Forest for our next two walks.

Meet in the new parking lot located on Almira Drive at Illahee Forest Preserve. From the traffic light on Highway #303 at Lowe’s Hardware, take Fuson Road up-the-hill and follow the hard right hand turn onto Almira Drive. The parking lot is just ahead on your left. Space is limited to about 12, so advanced sign up is recommended.
