CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

1. Registration will be available 30 minutes before the competition. Entry is free.
2. By signature on the application form, the participant accepts the following regulations.
3. The competitors of the various categories will be presented together to the jury and will remain on the stage. The evaluation of each competitor will take place individually.
4. The decision of the jury is not contestable.
5. Protests against the decision of the jury will lead to disqualification of the competitor.
6. The evaluation follows a point system. Each competitor is awarded between five and ten points, half points are possible. The evaluation is presented openly by each judge's display of the given points.
7. After entry has been made, a change of class will not be permitted.

THE JURY

1. The organizer composes the jury.
2. The jury consists of seven judges.
3. In the evaluation, the greatest and least point award will be dropped.
4. The jury chairman is the senior judge. It is the jury chairman's responsibility to settle any disagreement between jury members and repeat an evaluation as necessary.

| Moustache | can start growing from less than a maximum of ½ inch beyond but not below the ends of the upper lip |
| Full Beard | facial hair on upper and lower lip, chin, cheeks, and sideburns, without natural or shaved gap |
| Partial Beard | any facial hair that does not qualify as a moustache or full beard (sideburns, goatee, soul patch, etc.) |
| Novice Class | open to any boy or girl who would like to enter – no fee. Bring your moustache & beard to wear on stage or make one before the competition. Materials will be available. |
