**CREATE A FUN AND INTERESTING SCARECROW TO DECORATE THE FAIRGROUNDS. SUGGESTED TOPICS ARE: TRADITIONAL, FANTASY, HUMOROUS, OR FAIR THEME. THE SCARECROW ENTRIES WILL BE SITED AROUND THE PRESIDENTS' HALL.**

1. Individuals or Groups of all ages may enter. One 5-day pass per entrant, group or organization.
2. Scarecrows should be self-standing or self supporting and waterproof and able to take wind and rain in true scarecrow tradition. Scarecrows must be all handmade and **No Manikins** allowed.
3. Small props allowed, such as a small garden chair, no overstuffed furniture. All props to be secured to the exhibit. No more than 4 figures in the group category.
4. Registration and set-up date is Monday before Fair from Noon to 8:00 p.m.
5. Display to be removed Monday after the Fair between 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m., unless other arrangements are made.
6. A name sign may be attached to the exhibit, no larger than 12 x 18 inches.
7. The Rodeo Queen & her court will do the judging.
8. The Fair Staff reserves the right to disqualify an entry deemed inappropriate for a family fair.
9. Scarecrows will be displayed/placed in the Heritage Garden area.

## DIVISIONS

Division 1 Youth 17 years & under  
Division 2 Adult 18 and over

**Class 1 Individual** (A Scarecrow couple is acceptable but individual is usually one scarecrow figure)

**Class 2 Group** (Family or Organization, No more than 4 figures)

## AWARDS

All entries will receive an award ribbon of First Place through Honorable Mention based on their overall score. Best of Show ribbon awarded to the overall Best Scarecrow. Superintendent's award will be awarded at the Superintendent's discretion.
