Lot 1	Archery Recurve Shoot	Event will be held Saturday at 8:00 p.m. & Sunday at 10:00 a.m. in the Archery Booth
Lot 2	Compound Field indoor Shoot	Event will be held Friday at 8:00 p.m. & Saturday at 10:00 a.m. in the Archery Booth
Lot 3	Bare Bow Shoot	Event will be held Thursday at 8:00 p.m. & Friday at 10:00 a.m. in the Archery Booth

### RULES

1. Advance registration required. (Sign up time Tuesday before Fair 10:00 a.m.)
2. Information for each Shoot will be available at sign up. (Distances and target sizes)
3. Level for members will be determined by age, using the 4-H age groups.
4. Open to Archery members who have passed the Basic Skills Test.
5. Maximum bow weight not to exceed forty (40) pounds. Field tips or target tips only.
6. Wooden arrows can't be used when shooting a compound bow.
7. Archer must only shoot at one of the two times listed.

Lot 4 Team Shoot Event will be held Thursday 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.

### RULES

1. Team will consist of three 4-H archery members, one from each age level. (Jr., Int., and Sr.). No person can be on more than one team.
2. Team will shoot at 20 yards at 60 cm 10-ring target.
3. Each team member will shoot 30 arrows with ten ends of three arrows.
4. Team will have one archer on recurve, one archer on bare bow and one archer on compound.

Lot 5 Archery Safety Poster

Lot 6 Regulation Concentric (round) target (not to exceed 60 cm) mounted, shot 5 ends of 6 arrows and scored by member. (Score sheet attached with distance designated. Score sheets available from Superintendents. Targets must be mounted prior to Fair starting)

Lot 7 Piece of archery equipment made by member (maximum of three different types per exhibitor). Must be made during 4-H year. May be used by member during the year.

Lot 8 Educational Archery Exhibit Judging of posters will use the same rules as Division II Lot 17
