

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Kitsap County Board of Commissioners will hold a public hearing on **June 18, 2007** beginning at the hour of **10:05 a.m.**, in its Chambers, County Administration Building, 619 Division Street, Port Orchard, Washington 98366 to consider an **Ordinance** setting the speed limit **Sidney Road SW** and further described as follows:

WHEREAS, RCW 46.61.415 provides that the Local Authority may determine and declare reasonable and safe maximum speeds, and

WHEREAS, on the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation, the Department of Public Works has determined maximum speed limits on various sections of Sidney Road SW,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Kitsap County Commissioners, in regular session assembled, that it is the intention of said Board, in the interest of public safety, to have certain regulatory speed limit signs erected as follows:

Sidney Road SW beginning at the Pierce/Kitsap County line, for a distance of 6500 ft. (1.2 miles) north, and ending 500 ft. north of SW Minterbrook Road, located in Sections 3 and 10, Range 1 East, Township 22 North, W. M., the speed limit shall be 35 mph.

Sidney Road SW beginning 500 ft. north of SW Minterbrook Road for a distance of 24422 ft. (4.6 miles) north, and ending 500 ft. south of SW Lider Road, located in Section 3, Range 1 East, Township 22 North, W. M., and Sections 14, 15, 22, and 23, Range 1 East, Township 23 North, W. M., the speed limit shall be 45 mph.

Sidney Road SW beginning 500 ft. south of SW Lider Road for a distance of 3885 ft. north to SW Sedgwick Road, located in Sections 10, 11, 14, and 15, Range 1 East, Township 23 North, W. M., the speed limit shall be 35 mph.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this order shall supersede any ordinances to the contrary that may have been passed previously and shall take effect immediately.

ALL THOSE INTERESTED are welcome to attend. **(Please note that hearing start times are estimates and may be impacted by the amount of public input).**
