Hazwoper Refresher Training Available

For those employees who need to attend the eight-hour Hazwoper Refresher Training, the course will be offered for Kitsap County employees on April 5, 8:00AM-4:00PM. Topics include toxicology, MSDS exercise, respiratory review, PPE review, site control, decontamination and hands-on activities. Registration and payment must be received by March 26, 2007.
