	The Transportation Element of our Comprehensive Plan Update (2024) clearly expresses a vision for a "safe, integrated, and sustainable multi-modal transportation system that supports the County's population, land use plan, and provides connections within and between communities." The NSTO project is an exemplary example of fulfilling the County's vision in that it provides much-needed non-motorized transportation within the Kingston Urban Growth Area, as well as connections between North Kitsap Heritage Park, Port Gamble Forest Heritage Park, and the communities of Indianola, Port Gamble, and Kingston. We believe the NSTO Trail project is a worthwhile investment for our multi-modal future.
	We know our communities lack non-motorized facilities. The NMFCAC is asking the BOCC to support everyone's ability to walk, ride, and roll through our county by allocating resources for the NSTO trail.
