1	Indianola Rd Shoulders	Construct paved shoulders, South Kingston Rd to Seaview Ave	Dave Haley - IBIC	Project not needed. Existing paved shoulder widths are sufficient given the current traffic volumes and speeds.
2	South Kingston Rd Shoulders	Construct paved shoulders and/or bike lanes	Dave Haley - IBIC, Duane Niemi, J. Drew	This is a much needed project, but is moved to the Tier 4 list at this time. There are significant right of way issues along this stretch of roadway, only 30' of ROW exists through tribal property, and the County only has the ability to maintain this road in it's current form. No widening or shoulder paving is possible at this time.
3	Loughery Rd Paving	Pave existing gravel road from Harris Ave. to Division St.	Carol Marsailles	Due to stormwater issues this is not a viable project for submittal this year. SSWM will be conducting a drainage study of the Indianola area next year. Once completed, we will revisit this request.
4	Miller Bay Rd Shoulders	Widen and pave shoulders from Indianola Rd to SR 104	Kingston Parks and Trails	Hold project on Tier 4 list for now. Project may not be needed if the trail through Heritage Park is approved, and accomplishes the same goal.
5	Ridgetop Blvd	Install stop signs and crosswalks in multiple locations between SR 303 and Silverdale Way	Robin Jensen	This is an operational issue and will be forwarded to the traffic operations division for follow-up.
6	Ridgetop Blvd Ped Crossing	Install pedestrian crossing lights at Clear Creek Trail	Kathleen Knuckey - Silverdale Chamber of Commerce	Traffic Operations division to install crossing lights this year.
7	Pave Road at Seabeck Elem School	Pave unpaved portion of roadway along new Seabeck Elementary school site.	Aline Holmstrom	This is an unmaintained county road. No maintenance is provided by County.
8	Parking along Point No Point Rd	Allow shoulder parking or provide additional parking for Point No Point Park.	Carol Wood	This would require repeal of a previous decision by the Board of County Commissioners. Parks department is pursuing the addition of parking at Point-No-Point park.
9	Glenwood Rd Safety Improvements	Widen and straighten roadway	Craig Montgomery	This project is already on the TIP, scheduled for construction in 2016.
10	Ohio Ave Safety Improvements	Install guard rails	Heather Ben-Judah	To be constructed through the traffic safety / guard rail program
11	West Kingston Rd Culvert	Replace undersized culvert near Miller Bay Rd	Jo Nelson	Culvert was surveyed and assessed by staff, and determined that existing culverts are of sufficient size.
12	Fairgrounds Rd Crosswalk	Paint Crosswalk at Tracyton & Fairgrounds Intersection	John C. Cohoon	This is an operational issue and will be forwarded to the traffic operations division for follow-up.
13	National Ave Potholes	Resurface roadway from Kitsap Way to McCall Blvd	Joseph Wines	This is a maintenance issue and will be forwarded to the road maintenance division for follow-up.
14	Spruce Rd Traffic Calming	Install rumble strips to slow traffic	Kevin LaCombe	This is an operational issue and will be forwarded to the traffic operations division for follow-up.

20	Central Kitsap Bike Ped Improvements	Build sidewalks and bicycle lanes on all major roads including the full length of HWY 303, Pine Road, McWilliams, Old Military, and Fairgrounds	Riddell North Owners Association	Project is too widespread, and is covered by specific projects outlined in the non-motorized plan.
21	Highland Rd SR 104 Intersection Improvements	Install new traffic signal	Robert Smaus	This area is under WSDOT jurisdiction. Foreword project request to WSDOT.
22	SR 303 & Ridgetop Intersection Improvements	Install Roundabout south side of SR 303.	Robin Jensen	Proximity to overpass makes this project infeasible. New traffic signal scheduled for this location, to be constructed in 2014, should resolve problems.
23	Park Blvd/Irwin Ave, Stormwater Runoff	Provide managed stormwater runoff	Ron Thomas	This is an unmaintained county road. No maintenance is provided by County.
24	Kitsap Mall Pedestrian Bridge	Build pedestrian bridge to cross Kitsap Mall Blvd. at Poplars Ave.	Kathleen Knuckey - Silverdale Chamber of Commerce	Current pedestrian activity does not warrant this project. Traffic operations department will monitor pedestrian activity and revive project idea if warranted.
25	Tremont Turn-lanes	Add center turn lanes to Old Clifton Rd/Tremont at Hwy 16	Steve DeCoy	This area is under WSDOT jurisdiction. Foreword project request to WSDOT.
26	Suquamish Way Right Turn-lane	Extend right turn-lane at approach to SR 305	Bruce Goodrich - SCAC	A project to extend the <b>left</b> turn-lane is being scored in Tier 2 for TIP consideration, and will negate the need for extension of the <b>right</b> turn-lane. No need for a second project to accomplish the same goal.
