When: Saturday, May 14, 2005, from 9 am to 4 pm
Cost: Free

There is no volume restriction for homeowners. Yard waste will not be accepted from businesses, landscapers, or commercial haulers even if it was generated by households.

Materials accepted:

Brush, branches, stumps, grass, leaves and clean lumber

Material NOT accepted:

Treated or painted lumber, railroad ties, garbage, plastics, tires, scrap metal, household hazardous waste

- Remember to cover and secure your load
- Other area drop box facilities will not accept yard waste for free
- No dump trucks or other commercial vehicles may bring waste

This program is part of an ongoing effort by Kitsap County Public Works to provide recycling alternatives to outdoor burning. The public may recycle their yard waste at North Mason Fiber Company year round seven days a week from 7 am to 5 pm. Call 360-275-0228 for rates.
