SETTLEMENT CONFERENCE REQUIREMENTS: At least five (5) court days prior to the Settlement Conference, all parties and counsel shall serve a complete Memorandum for Settlement upon the other party and provide the original for the Settlement Conference Judge. The parties shall, in all cases, be present, unless excused by the court for good cause shown. Parties whose defense is provided by a liability insurance company, shall personally attend said settlement conference and a representative of the insurer of said parties shall attend or be available by telephone, with sufficient authority to bind the insurer to a settlement. [See KCLCR 16(c)]

SETTLEMENT CONFERENCES ARE MANDATORY AND MUST BE CONFIRMED NO LATER THAN NOON THE COURT DAY BEFORE THE CONFERENCE AT (360) 337-7140. PARTIES MUST BE PREPARED TO SERIOUSLY NEGOTIATE SETTLEMENT.
