## Illahee Shores fire

# Homicide suspected in death of park resident

Ref: Kitsap County Sheriff's Office news release #09-060, Oct. 31, 2009

**East Bremerton, Wash.** -- The Kitsap County Coroner and the county's forensic pathologist have just concluded an autopsy of the deceased person found in the charred rubble of a singlewide pre-manufactured residence located in the Illahee Shores Mobile Home Park yesterday morning.

The coroner has advised that the body is that of an adult woman, whose identity still has yet to be confirmed.

The Kitsap County Sheriff's Office continues with the investigation into the woman's death. ***It has now been classified as a homicide investigation.***

The sheriff's office is not releasing additional information at this time. Further information may be made available to the public when determined by the sheriff's chief of detectives.
