Two sex offenders wanted for failure to register

Port Orchard, Wash. -- Kitsap County Sheriff's detectives are releasing the following information, pursuant to RCW 4.24.550, regarding two sex offenders who have violated provisions of their release from incarceration by failing to register with the sheriff's office of their residence jurisdiction.

Both offenders are currently wanted for probation violations by the Washington State Department of Corrections (DOC). DOC warrants have been issued for their arrest. Arrest warrants out of Kitsap County Superior Court are pending.

Name: William Charles Moose, white male, age 20.

Status: *Moose is classified as a level III sex offender*, considered highly likely to re-offend.

Residence location: Moose had previously registered with the Kitsap County Sheriff's Office as a transient. As such he is required by law to check-in with the sheriff's office weekly. Moose last checked-in with the sheriff's office on Oct. 14, 2008. He was required to check-in again on Tuesday, Oct. 21. As of today Moose has not made any attempt to contact the sheriff's office.

Description: 6' 01" ht., 175 lbs. wt., hair: red, eyes: green. Tattoo on right shoulder.

Criminal history: According to court records, Moose was convicted of statutory sexual seduction on Oct. 14, 2005 in Lander County, Nevada and served 298 days incarceration. He has been arrested several times for probation violations. He was last released from prison on May 27, 2008 after serving seven months of a 13 month sentence for failure to register as a convicted sex offender.

Name: Ernie Sandoval Jr., Hispanic male, age 24.

Status: *Sandoval is classified as a level I sex offender.*

Residence location: Sandoval had previously registered with the Kitsap County Sheriff's Office as residing in the City of Bremerton. He has numerous probation violations and convictions for not actually living at the registered address. Sandoval was most recently released from prison on Oct. 13, 2008 and he registered with the sheriff's office as a transient, which requires him to check-in with the sheriff's office weekly. On Oct. 21 Sandoval failed to check-in as required. As of today Sandoval has not made any attempt to contact the sheriff's office.

Description: 5' 10" ht., 160 lbs. wt., hair: black, eyes: brown. Numerous tattoos on face, neck, arms, hands and torso.

Criminal history: According to court records, Sandoval was convicted of rape of a child, 3rd degree on Sept. 29, 2003 in Kitsap County Superior Court and sentenced to 27 months incarceration. He was released from prison on July 18, 2005.
