## Two in custody for multiple burglaries

**Silverdale, Wash.** -- Two men are now in custody on a variety of charges stemming from investigations into multiple residential burglaries in the Central and North Kitsap areas of the county.

Sheriff's patrol deputies and detectives have been involved in burglary investigations that occurred in October and early November. A number of them appeared to be connected and several were in close proximity to each other.

A neighbor of two of the property victims was able to provide images from an installed video surveillance system that assisted in identifying possible suspects.

Sheriff's detectives began gathering information and compiling data on the suspects.

One of the suspects was observed driving a vehicle that had previously been identified as being involved in the crimes. A sheriff's patrol deputy stopped the vehicle, last night, for a traffic infraction and subsequently arrested him for driving under the influence of alcoholic intoxicants. The driver was subsequently interviewed by detectives and additional information and leads was developed.

At approximately 2:30 a.m. today sheriff's detectives served a search warrant on a residence in the 14100 block of Thomas Drive NW, Silverdale. During the course of the search warrant detectives took the second suspect into custody.

Investigators believe that both suspects were involved in at least six residential burglaries, including one committed yesterday, with the identification of additional victims expected.

Detectives recovered a significant amount of stolen property items from the second suspect's residence, to include:

- Various electronic components such as large, flat screen televisions, a laptop computer, Xbox video game and controllers, flat screen computer monitors and digital cameras.
- Extensive amounts of jewelry to include watches, rings and earrings.
- Firearms, including various rifles, shotguns and a handgun as well as firearm ammunition.

- A collection of 40(+) vinyl LP record albums from the '60s, '70s and '80s.
- Compact discs.
- Coins and other monetary denominations.
- Household items, such as dining utensils, suitcases and backpacks.
- Edged weapons.
- Other miscellaneous items.

The value of the recovered property exceeds \$25,000.

Both suspects were transported and booked into Kitsap County Jail:

**Name: Tony Dean Capps**, age 24, a resident of Silverdale, Central Kitsap.

**Booking charges:**

- (1) Residential burglary
- (2) Being a felon in possession of a firearm
- (3) Trafficking in stolen property
- (4) DUI

Bail: \$100,000.

**Name: Corey Michael Smith**, age 27, a resident of Silverdale, Central Kitsap.

**Booking charges:**

- (1) Residential burglary
- (2) Being a felon in possession of a firearm
- (3) Trafficking in stolen property

Bail: \$300,000.

Capps and Smith are scheduled to appear in Kitsap County Superior Court at 3:00 p.m. today on the above charges.
