Two dead in Navy Yard City crash

Bremerton, Wash. -- Kitsap County Sheriff's traffic deputies are investigating a single vehicle, double-fatality crash that occurred during the early morning hours yesterday.

Location: National Avenue South at McCall Boulevard West, in the Navy Yard City area of Bremerton, just north of State Highway 304.

Time & date: 12:51 a.m., Sunday, Nov. 8. Sheriff's patrol deputies arrived at 12:56 a.m. Engine and Medic units from both South Kitsap Fire & Rescue and Bremerton Fire Department responded to the crash, with first units arriving on scene at 1:01 a.m.

Involved:

Vehicle: 2004 Dodge Stratus 4-door.

- Driver: male, age 24, residence status not confirmed. Airlifted to Harborview Medical Center, Seattle. Injuries are not considered life threatening.
- Front seat passenger: Laresa Ann Davis, age 28, from Bremerton, was declared deceased at the scene.
- Rear seat passenger: Nina Terumi Martinez Gonzalez, age 27, from Bremerton, was declared deceased at the scene.

Synopsis:

Although the investigation is in its early stages, a preliminary analysis by traffic investigators indicates that the Dodge Stratus was traveling southbound on National Avenue South and left the roadway at McCall Boulevard West.

The vehicle went airborne and came down into a ravine, where it struck a dirt embankment that stopped its forward momentum.

Sheriff's deputies are still conducting evidence analysis to determine the vehicle's speed. It is unknown if the ingestion of alcohol or narcotics, by the driver, are contributing factors. Further information may be made available publicly as the investigation continues.
