Silverdale bank robbery

Silverdale, Wash. -- Kitsap County Sheriff's detectives, working in conjunction with special agents of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), are investigating a mid-morning robbery of a Central Kitsap branch of Bank of America.

The robbery occurred at 9:13 a.m. at the branch office located in Clear Creek Centre, 10574 Silverdale Way NW, Silverdale. A single adult male stepped up to a teller's position and handed a note to a bank employee demanding money. No weapon was displayed, nor was use of a weapon threatened.

After taking an undisclosed amount of money from the bank teller, the suspect was last seen leaving the bank on foot in an unknown direction.

Kitsap County Central Communications (9-1-1 dispatch) was first notified of the robbery at 9:15 a.m. Sheriff's patrol deputies were on-scene at 9:17 a.m. to initiate the investigation and assist with searching surrounding locales.

Sheriff's detectives provided a description of the suspect as:

- White male, 20 to 25 years of age.
- 5' 06" to 5' 10" in height, thin build, clean shaven.
- Wearing a dark-blue hooded sweatshirt, black-colored jeans, dark-colored athletic shoes with white stripes and a dark-colored baseball hat that had a green-colored bill. The suspect had the hood of the sweatshirt pulled up over his head.

A photograph depicting the suspect inside the bank is attached. The photograph was obtained from the bank's video surveillance system.
