Safety Supplies Checklist

At least ten days before the clean up activity, check your Agreement to determine what supplies are recommended to support your clean up activity. Determine the number of people expected to participate. Reserve and pick up the necessary supplies from the closest location noted in your Agreement.

 - Agreement, Signed Registrations, etc.
- Safety training materials
- First aid kit
- Safety vests
- Gloves
- Safety glasses
- Bags
- Bag holders
- Long-handled collection tools
- Traffic control plan
 - “Litter Crew Ahead” signs and stands
 - Traffic cones
- Clip boards with pens
- Paperwork (blank copies of each)
 - Volunteer Agreement and Roster
 - Adult Registration
 - Youth Registration
 - Safety Equipment Log
 - Accident Report
