Tamara discussed draft Chapters 7 (Solid Waste Transfer System) and 8 (Disposal), which had been distributed to the committee.

The following suggestions were made in addition to what was printed in the draft document:

Chapter –7 – Solid Waste Transfer System

I. Transfer System Program Strategies

Short Term Actions

- Use the Olalla site for Construction and Debris (C&D) materials
- If the Olalla site is to be closed, close it in phases, weekend hours only, etc.
- Raise the minimum fee for self-haulers
- Modify operations at OVTS to include a C&D program

ROUND TABLE

KCPWSWD – Pat Campbell

- Leslie Medeiros has been hired and will begin work December 15 as the new RAGF Facility Supervisor
- A countywide newsletter project is near completion

- Timeline for Plan adoption (tentative):
 - March – Preliminary draft of Plan to the Board of Commissioners for review
 - Distribution of preliminary draft to cities, Ecology, and the public
 - The Ecology review process can take up to ninety days
 - July 2009 – Adoption by cities and County

Bainbridge Disposal – Heather Church

- The customer commodity credit program for curbside recycling is currently being evaluated
- A minimum charge for scrap metal is being considered
- The process of converting the drop box building to a transfer station is ongoing

Navy – John Lacy

- Non-contaminated glass is now taken locally at Fred Hill Materials

Waste Management – Terry Bickel

- The recycling numbers are up for residential customers and down for commercial customers
- Waste Management will be collecting food from their customers and will deliver what is collected to the local food banks
- The tonnage numbers at OVTS for November were the lowest since opening
- The single stream recycling program will begin January 1 at Bangor and PSNS, with new carts being delivered

South Kitsap – Daniel Roloff – No report.

City of Poulsbo – Denise Bauman

- Property has been purchased as a new site for the Public Works office

Kitsap County Health District – Grant Holdcroft

- Ongoing investigations into old landfill sites

North Kitsap – Kinley Deller

- Customers would like to have labels put in the recycling section describing what or what not to recycle at Hansville
