ESTABLISHMENT:

Kitsap County created the Substance Abuse Advisory Board pursuant to the Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 70.96A.300.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Function as part of a team. Provide information and recommendations to the Kitsap County Board of Commissioners and citizens regarding substance abuse treatment and prevention programs funded through Kitsap County. SAAB reviews all service plans, applications for funding and expenditure budgets.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Members must be Kitsap County residents. Candidates must be willing and able to attend monthly meetings. No member may be a provider of alcoholism and other drug addiction treatment services. To meet state requirements there is a need for members with affiliation with education, human services and/or job training.

MEMBERSHIP:

Up to nine members, who are representative of the community, are chosen to serve on the SAAB for their demonstrated concern for alcoholism and other drug problems. The RCW requires one quarter of the membership to be recovered addicts and must include minority group representation. Members are volunteers who serve without compensation. Terms of appointment are for three years.
