Fred Depee gave a short presentation on the history of his property located off of Jessica at Beach Drive and talked about his request for a vacation of a piece of the land. Questions were asked about drainage and access to the development. Mr. Depee said all departments signed off on his request. The county commissioners will be voting on the vacation on February 25.

Scott Diener gave a presentation on streamlining the permitting process for tree harvesting. The Department of Natural Resources (DNR) used to be in charge of the premitting process but they have requested that local authorities take over. The Department of Community Development (DCD) is working toward that end and meeting with all the Kitsap County Community Advisory Committees to discuss the changes in an effort to show transparency. Many questions were asked about site assessments and site evaluations. Scott said there is a check list available for people who want to do tree removals.

The 2018 Work plan was reviewed voted on and passed with changes made.

The January minutes were voted on and passed with only one abstention.

The meeting adjourned at 8:15 and the next meeting is scheduled for March 5th.
