6:32 meeting called to order by Carol Malmquist

Commissioner Garrido made opening comments- She attended a Kitsap Regional Coordinating Council meeting with Joe Tovar as a speaker. This meeting is available on BKAT. She spoke on the water trails being established to include signage. It was suggested signage include water safety. She also mentioned tiny homes for the homeless being established in the county.

August minutes were not available for approval.

Signage – Communities are allowed 4 signs. It was suggested to move the sign on Beach Drive to the edge of the LAMIRD north of E Jessica Way and to move the sign on Colchester to the corner of Alaska Avenue and Mile Hill. Other signs should be posted on California Avenue and Nebraska Avenue near Mile Hill.

Clear cutting on Beach Drive-Fred Depee has done additional clearing. He has been asked to come and talk with DCD. There is a stopwork order in place. BLA's created all lots to 8,712sq. ft..

BLA ordinance creation- is now 40% complete and should be ready for approval in the first quarter of 2018.

Reports- The August MCA Flea Market and Festival was very successful. Special thanks to the water district for their help with cooking.

The port has new signage and would like input.

Sewer design for Colchester is 90% completed.

New items-

It was reported that there have been leaks at pump station #47. Health an sewer department are taking care of it.

We need to post on "What's Happening in Manchester" that we are looking for new members to the advisory committee.

It was reported that a house on Harrison has 4 hens, 3 duck and 1 rooster who crows throughout the day and night. We have been asked at the next zoning update that we include hens yes, roosters no.
