



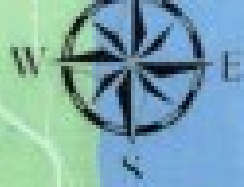

Clark Construction- Monday, September 18, 2023, 0800.

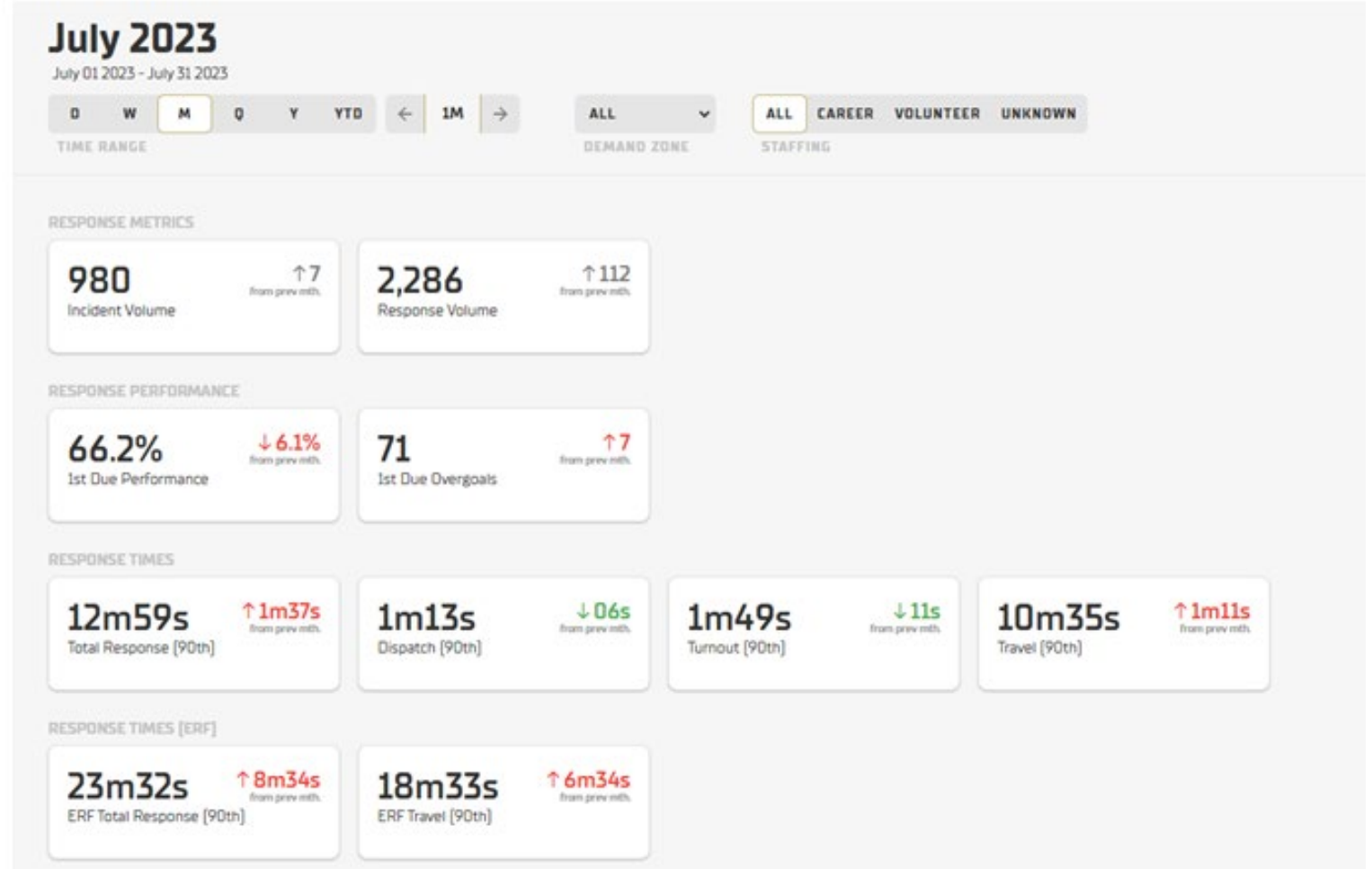

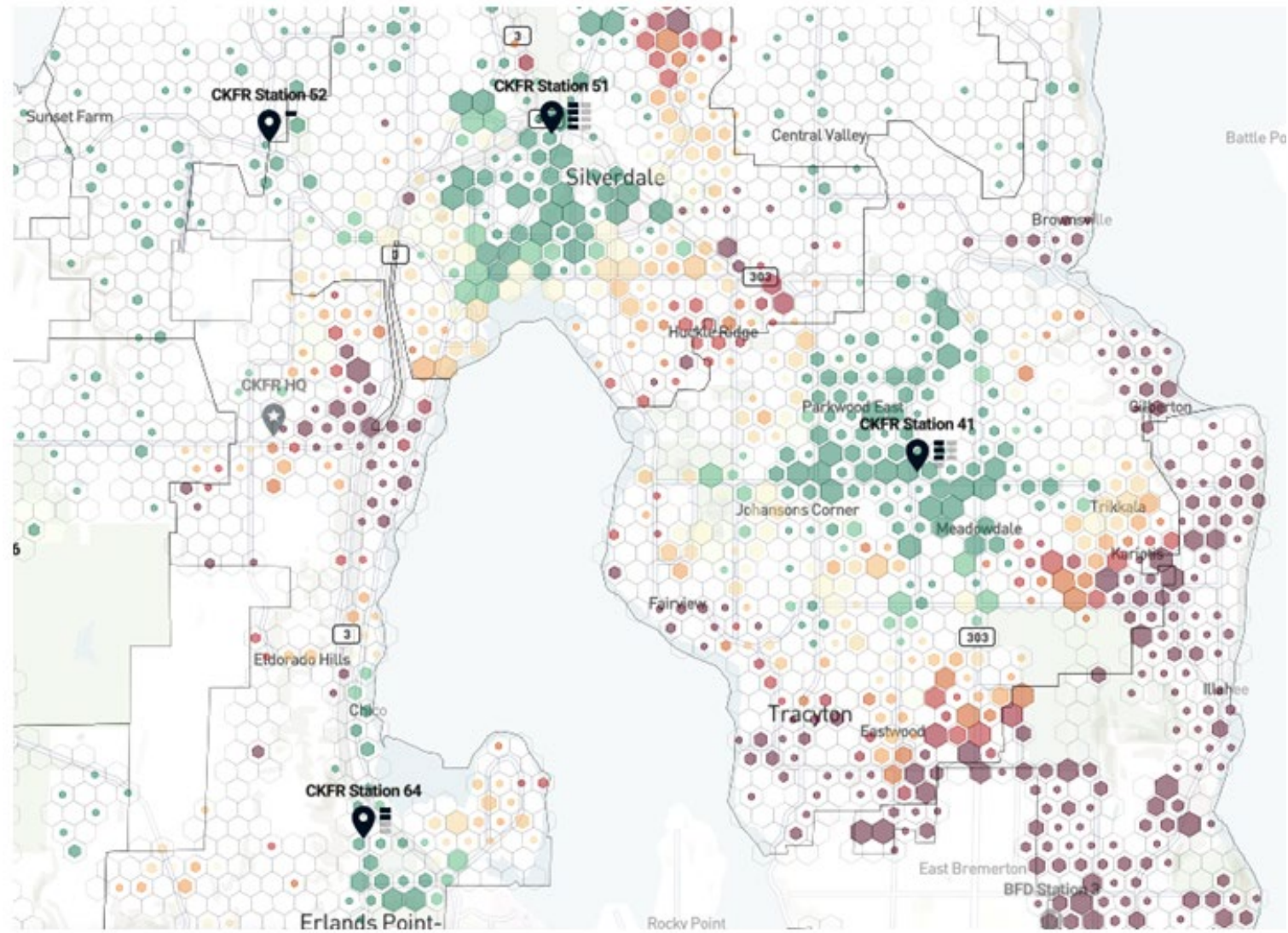


# Data Analytics- Data Poor to Data Smart

Dashboard of performance at the 90<sup>th</sup>%

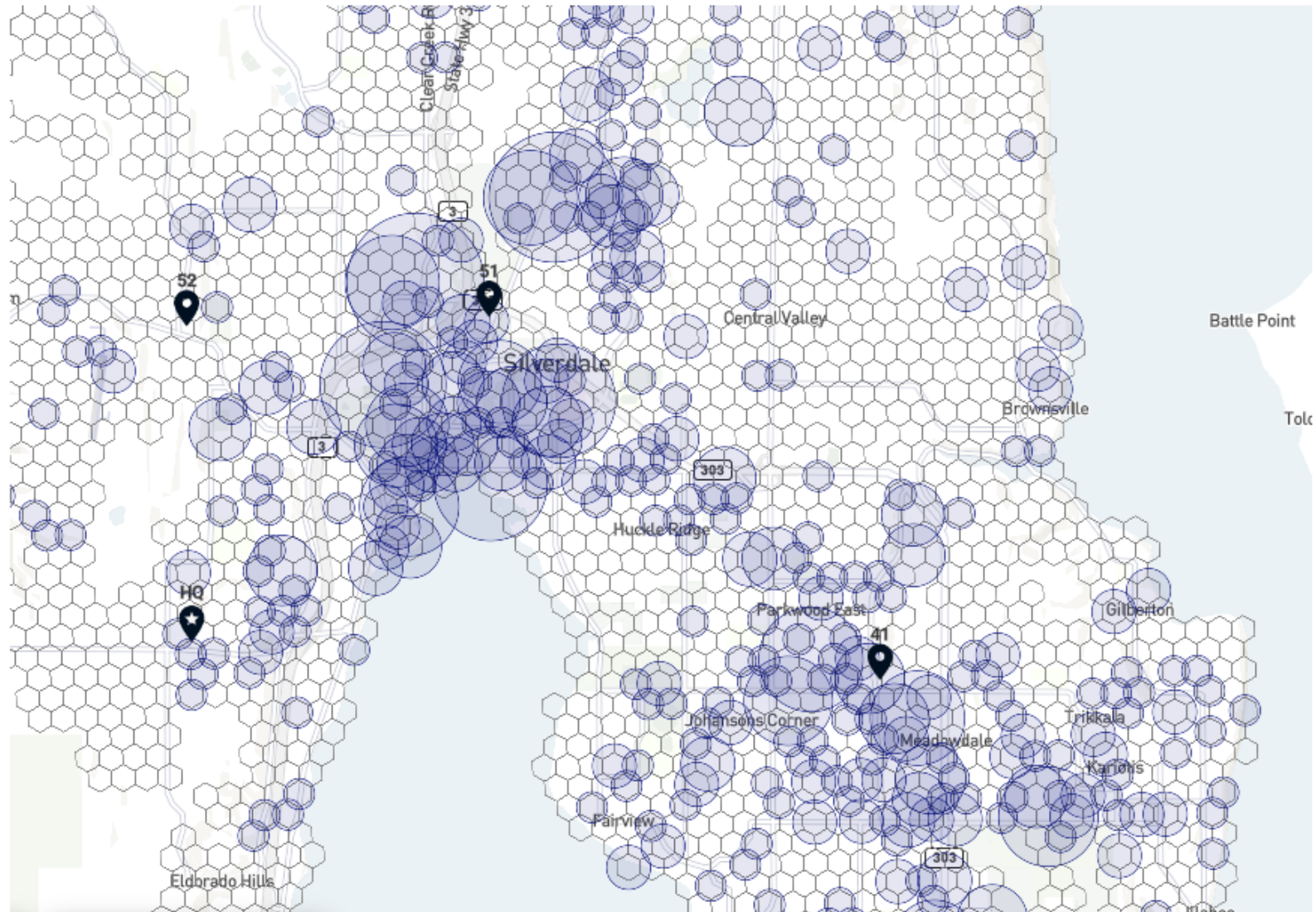


Performance of first arriving unit. Highlights the challenge of 45 being closed.
