Minutes of September 7, 2021 MCAC Meeting

John Gese is the newly appointed Sheriff, filling the position vacated by Gary Simpson. He is bringing his 30 years of experience to the Sheriff's Office to help adapt to Covid-19 related challenges, including low staffing, Covid-19 outbreaks and more.

Janelle Overton asked about the staffing situation. John Gese clarified that 10% of budgeted positions are vacant, and they are trying to fill with more diverse staffing. Zoni Hansen asked what types of policies John Gese plans to promote in office. He confirmed that although pricey, body cameras are a main goal for the department. Community attendees, Terence, Susan Shaw and Zoni Hansen share concerns of local crime rising and wonder what citizens can do to help law enforcement. There was discussion about a vagrant who was living on a derelict sailboat who steals things from waterfront properties. John Gese suggests that citizens continue to report and take pictures of violations.

Review and approve August minutes:

Ray Pardo moved to pass with corrections. Paul Nuchims seconds. The minutes were passed unanimously with corrections.

Member Items:

The Manchester Flea Market and Festival was a huge success. Many community members attended and hosted booths, including South Kitsap High School ASB representatives who plan to attend future Manchester Festivals.
