Assumption of authority through permitting and enforcement will encourage forest practices in the County to adhere to the requirements of the State Forest Practices Act, the State Environmental Policy Act, and the County Comprehensive Plan. There has been a lot of tree harvesting in the last two years due to high timber values – what will this mean to the average citizen, as well as those with forest land in the county?
