PROCEEDINGS

Meeting began at 6:08 PM.

Public Comment Jennifer Sutton discussed an upcoming Suquamish School PTSA fundraiser (Saturday, 5/20/17 at 6 PM). Additionally, she voiced a concern for speeding in vicinity of Suquamish schools.

March 2017 Meeting Minutes were approved.

Meeting Core

Asst. Chief Almirol discussed burglaries have been due to failure of individuals to secure their houses and vehicles.

Scott Crowell (Suquamish Tribal DCD) was unfortunately unavailable to discuss the Suquamish Shore Architectural vision presented during the April Open House.

The Work Plan was reviewed and discussed. Pen and ink updates were noted for:

- Annual Administrative Tasks #1, 4 and 6 were complete with Administrative Task#2 second cleanup being planned for October. Task #3 was achieved with the welcome of Sharon Griffin! Task #7 was modified to investigate increasing the map area north to include the Cowling Creek Preserve facility and trails.
- For the Tasks Linked to the Comprehensive Plan, Task #3 was modified to "Ongoing" with the language being modified to be more focused on "monitoring to TIP completion".

Updates:

- James ST Road End update (Will M.): Cat5 Permit was approved, the Grant funds are available and work will begin shortly.
- Suquamish Merchants Association update (Tom Curley for Thornton P): Tom related that the local business survey was underway.
- Division/Irwin connecting trail Cowling Creek Preserve (Tom C.): KC completed the right of way survey and the effort is moving forward with the engagement of Paul Dorn and the local Girl Scouts.

- Suquamish Cleanup was once again a success and the next cleanup is planned for October ideally to help mitigate leaf and debris obstruction of drainage.
- April F. was not available for an update.
- TIP was reviewed and Tom C. noted that Brian A. had submitted a TIP entry for Columbia Rd as discussed in the March Meeting.
- Kevin McD was not available for a Kitsap Transit update but discussion continued to echo a dissatisfaction with diminishing local service.


